Further, in order to provide the court adequate time to consider the matter, we hereby issue a temporary stay of the district court's November 1, 2013, memorandum opinion and order, and we grant temporary injunctive relief pending further order of this court:

 The Federal Defendants-Appellees are enjoined from dispatching inspectors to the horse slaughterhouse facilities operated by Valley Meat Company, LLC; Responsible Transportation, LLC; and Rains Natural Meats.

 The Federal Defendants-Appellees are ordered to suspend or withhold the provision of horse meat inspection services to Valley Meat Company, LLC;
Responsible Transportation, LLC; and Rains Natural Meats.
