3	1. On July 8, pursuant to the Court's Scheduling Order [Dkt. 20], Defendants filed their
4	motion to dismiss or transfer venue [Dkt. $\frac{22}{26}$ ].
5	2. Having further conferred, the parties have agreed to a voluntary transfer to the District
6	of New Mexico, and have requested that this Court enter an order transferring the action. The
7	Court finds that the District of New Mexico is a proper venue for this action.
8	3. Given the preliminary relief requested in this action, and the mutually agreed need for
9	an expedited hearing on the matter, the Court directs that transfer proceed immediately.
10	4. The Court further directs the Clerk of the Court that this order granting transfer shall
11	take effect immediately upon entry, as an exception to Civil Local Rule 3-14, and that the matter
