USFS has a 1932 aerial photograph of the Sackett site and surrounding area. No roads or houses are visible in the area at the time of the photo. Jill stated that the wetland area appeared to be continuous to Priest Lake with possibly a trail along the lake shore. The wetland area appeared to narrow a bit close to the lake. Jill viewed the photograph stereoscopically and found the area appears very flat throughout the wetland area.

I will view the aerial photograph on May 15, 2008.

You can clearly see the wetland and a couple of older trails. I think the wetland almost reached the lake & probably had either a short single thread channel leading into it or met the

lake.

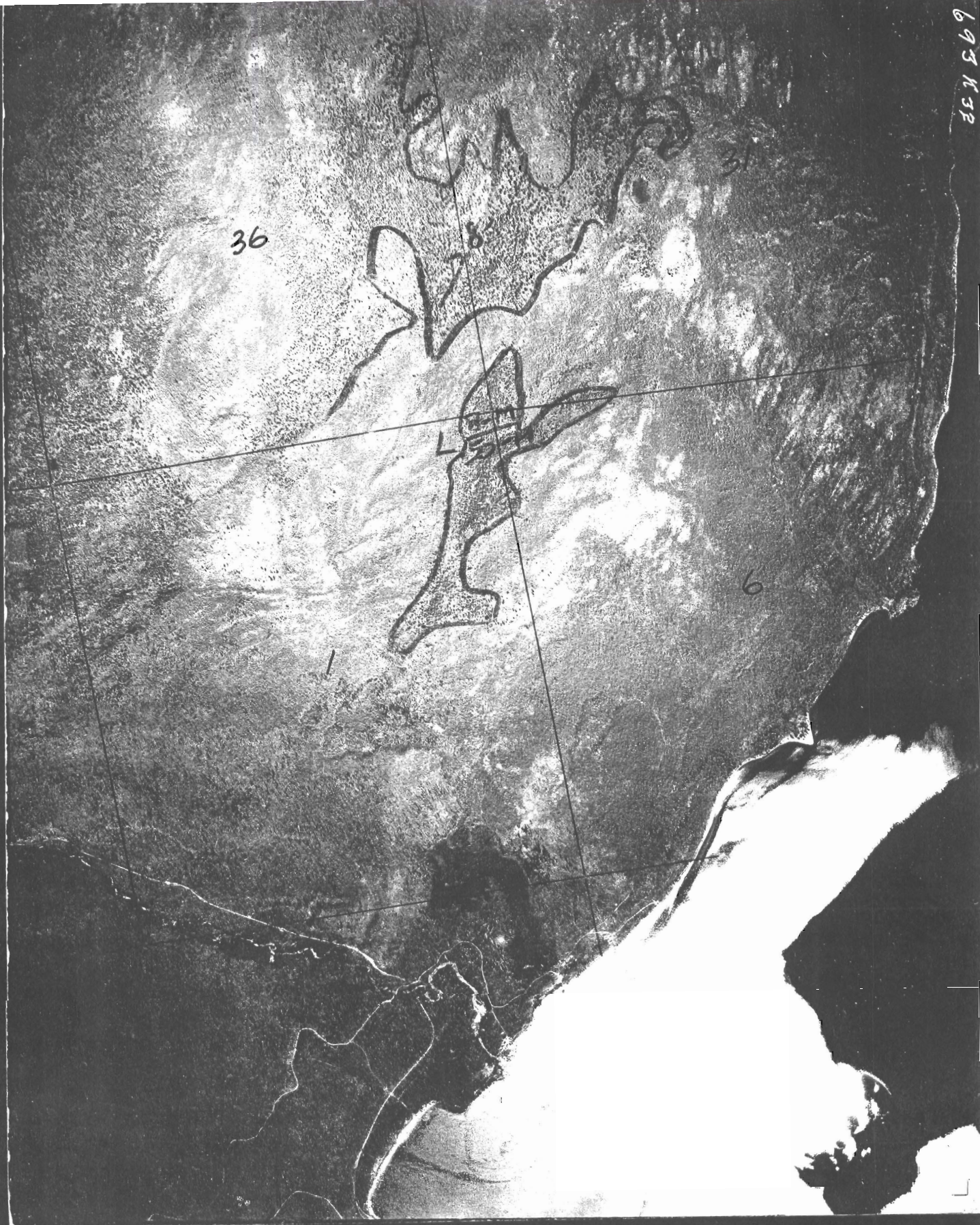
The stereoscope is located back in "Benders" old office. Have someone take you there to review photos.
