## CONDITIONS AND AUTHORIZATIONS:


- A. GENERAL CONDITIONS SET OUT IN SUBPART D OF 50 CFR 13, AND SPECIFIC CONDITIONS CONTAINED IN FEDERAL REGULATIONS CITED IN BLOCK #2 ABOVE, ARE HEREBY MADE A PART OF THIS PERMIT. ALL ACTIVITIES AUTHORIZED HEREIN MUST BE CARRIED OUT IN ACCORD WITH AND FOR THE PURPOSES DESCRIBED IN THE APPLICATION SUBMITTED. CONTINUED VALIDITY, OR RENEWAL, OF THIS PERMIT IS SUBJECT TO COMPLETE AND TIMELY COMPLIANCE WITH ALL APPLICABLE CONDITIONS, INCLUDING THE FILING OF ALL REQUIRED INFORMATION AND REPORTS.
- B. THE VALIDITY OF THIS PERMIT IS ALSO CONDITIONED UPON STRICT OBSERVANCE OF ALL APPLICABLE FOREIGN, STATE, LOCAL OR OTHER FEDERAL LAW.
- C. VALID FOR USE BY PERMITTEE NAMED ABOVE.
- D. Acceptance of this permit serves as evidence that the permittee understands and agrees to abide by the "general permit conditions" (COPY ATTACHED).
- E. Permittee is authorized to take sooty mangabeys (*Cercocebus torquatus syn. atys*), by collection of blood, skin, bone marrow, tissue, lymph node biopsy, cerebral spinal fluid, semen, and ova samples; and doing MRI scanning for the purpose of scientific research.
- F. Permittee is NOT authorized under the authority of this permit to initiate any studies which would be lethal to the animals or would require disease transmission to animals.
- G. Permittee is responsible for ensuring that all sample collection is conducted by veterinarians or scientists who are appropriately trained in the collection techniques.
- H. Permittee must submit an annual report by March 31 each year of activities conducted under this permit, during the duration of this permit. Annual report must include a description of studies initiated after the effective date of this permit, a summary of activities conducted under the permit by species, and copies of any publications that result from scientific research conducted under this permit.
