DEFENDANT’S NOTICE OF PARTIAL WITHDRAWAL OF MOTION

Defendant Feld Entertainment, Inc. (“FEI”) hereby withdraws the portion of its Motion to Compel the Production of Documents Subpoenaed from Meyer Glitzenstein & Crystal (“MGC”) (2/15/08) (Docket No. 257) (“Motion”) that sought electronic documents. Specifically, FEI withdraws its request that MGC be compelled to produce the electronic copies of letters from the Wildlife Advocacy Project to plaintiff Tom Rider. The originals of such letters were produced for FEI’s inspection on Thursday, February 21, 2008. The originals also were produced and presented for evidence at the February 26, 2008 hearing pursuant to subpoena and were returned to the custodian of records for Meyer Glitzenstein & Crystal at that hearing. FEI is satisfied with its inspection and use of the originals, and thus, does not need to inspect the electronic copies of the same. Therefore, FEI hereby withdraws Section B of the Argument in its Motion, which is located on pages 9-10.

The remainder of FEI’s Motion remains in effect and is not hereby withdrawn.
