Dear Ms. Joiner:

I did not receive your letter dated September 2, 2008 regarding Plaintiffs' Pre-trial Statement until Wednesday afternoon, as I was out of town.

In response to your questions concerning Plaintiffs' Exhibits 1 and 2, which are the medical records of all of the elephants and the medical records of the seven elephants with whom Tom Rider worked that are still in defendant's possession – Jewell, Karen, Nicole, Lutzi, Mysore, Susan, and Zina – Dr. Ensley did in fact rely on all of these medical records to form his expert opinions in this case.¹ As you know, we provided a list of the Bates Labels for all such documents as an Attachment to his Report, and on August 23, 2008, we had a CD-Rom delivered to you that contains a copy of each of those records. All of the medical records contained on that CD Rom will be included in Exhibit 1; the medical records for the seven elephants will be additionally included as a separate Exhibit 2. Dr. Ensley states in his Expert Report that his opinions are based on a review of all of these records.



Second, I have attached a list of plaintiffs' witnesses with a description of their testimony. With few exceptions, this information was provided to defendant a while ago, each time we disclosed our potential witnesses, as required by Rules 26(a)(1) and 26(e). I have also included an estimate of the time needed to present the testimony of each such witness. While doing this, I realized that we inadvertently omitted expert witness Ajay Desai from the list of witnesses on the Pre-trial Statement we filed last week – so I have added him here. We will file an amended Pre-trial Statement soon so that Judge Sullivan has all of this information.

As an additional matter, we note that defendant's Pre-trial Statement relies heavily on information that is currently subject to the protective order that Judge Facciola issued in this case on September 25, 2007 at the request of defendant, DE 195 – i.e., information that was disclosed in discovery after September 25, 2007, including information about funding of Tom Rider's public education efforts, information disclosed during both fact witness and expert depositions, information about what occurred at the Court-ordered inspections, and information that is included in various expert reports. Please clarify your position as to why defendant referred to such information in its recent public filings, so that we can have a mutual understanding of what is permitted in this regard. If we do not hear back from you on this point by the end of the day Monday, September 8, we will assume that now that this case is set for trial, it is defendant's position that Judge Facciola's protective order no longer applies with respect to all future filings before Judge Sullivan.
