DECLARATION

- I, Lisa Zeiler Joiner, declare under oath as follows:
- 1. I practice with the law firm of Fulbright & Jaworski LLP ("Fulbright"), which has been retained by Feld Entertainment, Inc. ("FEI") as counsel in this case. I am counsel of record to FEI in this case.
- 2. The document Bates labeled FEI 42474-42478 is a nine-page fax dated February 20, 1998. It was sent from the Baltimore Arena to Mark Gaipo, who was the General Manager for the Red Unit at that time. FEI's original of this document was sent to counsel for production. This document was produced in redacted form on October 11, 2006 pursuant to the Court's September 26, 2006 Order ("Order"). The Court's Order required the production of interstates, and they were collected and produced pursuant to the Order.
- 3. For the October 11, 2006 production, the interstates were processed at Fulbright as follows: If an interstate contained multiple animals including elephants, a line-by-line redaction was undertaken. See, e.g., FEI 42476. If an interstate contained only elephants, it was

produced without redaction. <u>See, e.g.</u>, FEI 42478. If an interstate contained only animals other than elephants, it was not responsive and not produced.

- 4. To the best of our recollection, we believe that the fax was a batch of interstates. This is based on our recollection as well as the nature of the fax itself and the subject matter of the production occurring. It is also consistent with Mr. Gaipo's recollection of the document. Some of the interstates in the fax contained elephants, and some of the interstates in the fax contained only animals other than elephants. Because the fax constituted a single document, the interstates that did not contain elephants were removed and replaced with slip sheets. We use slip sheets to indicate the removal of pages from a document when produced. Two of these slip sheets were inserted, and they are identified as FEI 42475 and FEI 42477.
- 5. When we pulled this document for *in camera* production in June 2008, we were unable to locate the non-responsive pages that had been removed. We routinely keep non-responsive documents when processing documents for production. Counsel searched our files in June 2008 and re-searched them again in August 2008 in order to locate the pages, but we were unable to find them. Because the original rather than a copy of this document was inadvertently processed for production, neither counsel nor FEI has a copy of it.
- 6. We apologize for the inability to locate and produce this document to the Court.

 FEI is not responsible for counsel's inability to find this document. We do not believe, however, that the missing pages relate to elephants.
