Hx: RH lameness exacerbated by performing "ferris wheel" which requires hind leg strength. Currently not in show

PE: Animal BAR, very active, moderate swinging leg lameness RH, can put full weight on RH without difficulty. Not on meds

Dx: Suspect hip, lower back - soft tissue injury? Discussed bone scan, thermography, ultrasound with Dr. Isaza

Tx: Continue to rest animal, possibly remove from show?

Lutzi: (elephant)

Hx: 2 year history of 200lb weight loss, followed by slow recovery. Blood work from 3 months ago WNL. Eats well. Has been on Ibuprofen for a while.

PE: Animal not underweight, but "lanky." BAR and active

Dx: Open. Discussed blood work, dental exam, fecal exam with owner

Tx: Stop ibuprofen, see how animal does. Tests above to be performed on next visit to blue unit.
