## ATTENDING VETERINARIAN AND ADEQUATE VETERINARY CARE (DEALERS AND EXHIBITORS).

Zena has a large swelling on her right rear leg just above the nails. The veterinarian has prescribed on course of treatment on 4/20/2006 consisting of a daily soak in oxytetracycline powder together with other treatments. The facility has no oxytetracycline powder, the staff was unaware that this medication should be administered, and does not know if any has been ordered.

Medical records only show treatments on 4-20-06 through 4-22-06 but the treatments continue to this date.

It is not possible to determine compliance and ensure the correct care without the documentation of those treatments. Consult with your veterinarian as to whether the oxytetracycline powder is required for treatment.
