

This letter will serve as confirmation of the following Animal Transactions:

- 1. The Niabi Zoo offers to accept as a donation and to be a companion elephant one (1) female Asian elephant, Elephas maximus ("Babe"), age 25, from the Center for Elephant Conservation.
- 2. The Niabi Zoo will receive from the Center for Elephant Conservation the above mentioned animal, provided the elephant is medically certified as healthy, is transported to the Niabi Zoo from its current home without cost to the Niabi Zoo, and the Center provides the Niabi Zoo with all appropriate records and permits necessary to document its legitimacy, physical health, and methods of husbandry and care.
- 3. It should be understood that once the elephant is transported to the Niabi Zoo and has been accepted by the Niabi Zoo, the Niabi Zoo assumes complete jurisdiction and management of the elephant in accordance with all appropriate standards from that point forward and all liability for any damages arising out of or relating to the animal, including, but not limited to attorney's fees.
- 4. The Center for Elephant Conservation agrees to allow an employee (or employees) of the Niabi Zoo to spend time at the Center prior to transport to interact with those who provide care to the elephant in an effort to familiarize them with the elephant and its management protocols.
- 5. The Niabi Zoo will permit the Center to have the elephant accompanied to the Niabi Zoo by one of the Center's employees who has provided care to the animal and will permit that employee to remain with the elephant for an adjustment period of up to three days initially; however, any such assistance by the Center shall not lessen the liability of the Niabi Zoo as set forth above.

- 6. Each institution will be responsible for the travel and per diem of its staff in support of this transaction.
- 7. Shipping arrangements will be made by the Center for Elephant Conservation with costs paid by the Center for Elephant Conservation. (Crates) will be provided by the Center for Elephant Conservation.
