Originally, when you hired me to do security at the new place, you told me that I could continue to speak out against Ringling Bros. I remember Sharon Sims sat me down and told me that I could do as much media as I wanted. But then, when you settled your lawsuit with Ringling, you and Sharon told me that as long as I was on PAWS's payroll I could not do any media against Ringling Bros. anymore. When you found out that I was planning to go to Washington to help the ASPCA at a press conference, you told me that I would be fired if I did that. So, I decided that I had to leave PAWS. I want to do everything in my power to help the elephants, and this means speaking out as much as possible about how Ringling Bros. beats them and especially mistreats the babies.
