① 3 young elephants chained side by side do not get along with each other and both are involved in long intense fights. I heard yelling and the sound of something hitting something. I observed one elephant holding an elephant with the ~~end~~ wooden end of the handling tool to get it up. I questioned the handler and he said the elephants did not get along and he would get over to down to control them because it was dangerous to get between them. Neither the elephant did not seem excessive and probably was not painful however the compatibility of the elephants sets up a situation that could lead to injury to the elephants or handler.




Section 3.137(a)(1) The floor of one of the transport-shift cages for the tigers is in need of repair because of a small hole in the floor. To be corrected by 3-10-2000.

Section 3.6(c)(iii) Primary enclosures, Additional requirements for Dogs- The interior height of a primary enclosure must be at least 6 inches higher than the head of the tallest dog in the enclosure when it is in a normal standing position. The boxer dog (Jack) and the St. Bernard dog (Dolly) and the dog named Goldie must have taller enclosures because of the dogs height. To be corrected by 2-24-2000.

3.10 Watering- The water dish is chewed and must be replaced because it cannot be properly cleaned and sanitized. To be corrected by 2-23-2000. The Act name is Donnert.






**CATEGORY I:** Non-compliant item(s) previously identified that have been corrected:

2.40. Veterinary Care: Report from May of 2000 documented an elephant exhibiting open lesion(s), possibly secondary to excessive use of an overly-sharp ankus hook. None of the <sup>5:45</sup> ~~12~~ elephants seen today exhibit any such lesions or scars.

Gorkovenko's (17 dogs), Donner (14 dogs) and Shemsheev (10 dogs and 12 cats) are three individuals performing with the circus. Neither of these individuals has a federal license, but rather are traveling under the red unit's auspices AND federal license. Each of the three groups owns their own animals, and the circus provides transportation, food, housing and mailing address for each.

No non-compliances identified this inspection.




This inspector was accompanied by Peter Cimini, RBBB Veterinary Technician. Mr. Cimini explained that the cars involved in the derailment were all sleeper cars, housing humans. No veterinary care issues were noted at the time of this inspection. A combination freezer/refrigerator truck is currently being used for meat product thawing.

**CATEGORY III: Non-compliant item(s) identified this inspection:**

**Section - 3.129 Feeding.** The food shall be wholesome, palatable and free from contamination. Several frozen bags of meat shanks were noted to have torn bags, exposing the feed to the environment before feeding. Multiple carrots were observed out of packaging and resting on the floor of the walk-in refrigerator. The metal tray used to hold recently refrigerator thawed meat before feeding contained fresh feed products but was contaminated with dried residue from previously stored products.





The remaining rhino lining was torn & had an protruding area that could be injurious to the 1 tiger occupying this enclosure by chewing on the rhino lining & then swallowing fragments of the lining.
