NOTICE

Section 1924, Title 28, U.S. Code (effective September 1, 1948) provides:

"Sec. 1924. Verification of bill of costs."

Ordinarily, the entry of judgment may not be delayed, nor the time for appeal extended, in order to tax costs or award fees. But if a timely motion for attorney's fees is made under Rule 54(d)(2), the court may act before a notice of appeal has been filed and become effective to order that the motion have the same effect under Federal Rule of Appellate Procedure 4(a)(4) as a timely motion under Rule 59.

FELD ENTERTAINMENT, INC.'S BILL OF COSTS

Pursuant to Fed.R.Civ.P. 54(d)(1) and LCvR 54.1, Defendant Feld Entertainment, Inc. ("FEI") hereby submits its Bill of Costs as itemized below:

I. FEI IS THE PREVAILING PARTY ON ALL COUNTS

Plaintiffs filed suit under the Endangered Species Act ("ESA"), 16 U.S.C. § 1531, et seq. claiming that Defendant's use of a tool, known as a "guide" or "bullhook" or "ankus," and the chaining of its Asian elephants violated the ESA. See, e.g., Complaint, Civ. Action No. 00-1641 (7/11/00). Plaintiffs filed a Second Amended Complaint on April 10, 2001, which the Court dismissed on June 29, 2001 for lack of standing. See Mem. Op. & Order, Civ. No. 00-1641 (6/29/01) (Docket #20). The Court of Appeals reversed that decision on February 4, 2003. See ASPCA v. Ringling Bros., 317 F.3d 334 (D.C. Cir. 2003).

On September 26, 2003, Plaintiffs filed another complaint, which was docketed as Civil Action Number 03-2006, alleging the same violations under the ESA against FEI. See, e.g., (Third) Complaint (9/26/03) (Docket #1). Plaintiffs initially sought injunctive relief and forfeiture for all 54 of FEI's elephants. *Id.* On August 23, 2007, the Court granted FEI summary

judgment as to 21 of its elephants that were subject to a captive-bred wildlife permit. *See ASPCA v. Ringling Bros.*, 502 F.Supp.2d 103 (D.D.C. 2007). On October 25, 2007, the Court granted in part Defendant's motion to reconsider its summary judgment ruling, and further granted summary judgment on all but 7 of its elephants. *ASPCA v. Ringling Bros.*, 246 F.R.D. 29 (D.D.C. 2007); Mem. Op. at 10 n.7 (12/30/09) (Docket #559).

Plaintiffs abandoned their request for forfeiture at a pre-trial hearing. *See* Minute Order (6/11/08). The case proceeded to trial on 7 elephants on February 4, 2009 and concluded on March 18, 2009. Plaintiffs abandoned their request for injunctive relief at trial. *See* Mem. Op. at 8 n.6 (12/30/09) (Docket #559). The parties submitted Proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, closing arguments concluded on July 14, 2009, and the Court then took the case under advisement. On December 30, 2009, the Court issued its ruling in favor of FEI and entered final judgment for FEI. *See* Order and Judgment (Docket #558), Mem. Op. (Docket #559).

Consequently, FEI is the prevailing party on all claims brought by Plaintiffs and is entitled to its costs incurred in successfully defending Plaintiffs' suit: "[C]osts—other than attorney's fees—should be allowed to the prevailing party." Fed.R.Civ.P. 54(d)(1)(emphasis added). The costs presented herein are true and accurate, reflecting amounts actually incurred by FEI. See Ex. 1 (Declaration of counsel for FEI).
