

Vet Rounds for CEC November 2000

"Rebbeca", Elephant, CEC, 11/19/00

HX – Presented for a sole abscess RH

PE – BAR. Good BC.

Chronic granulating lesion in the central sole of the RH foot. The lesion is filled with protruding granulating tissue. Trimmed the sole around the lesion to expose the borders.

Two small papelloma type warts on the caudal (outside) surface of the left ear.

One small (1x1x1 cm) raised soft mass on the skin of the upper left flank.

Aspirated fat like fluid from the lesion. I will submit slides for cytology.

A: Monitor foot and raised masses

P: The lesion needs conservative trimming every week

HX – Normal exam

PE – The ventral portion of RT cornea has a focal white area.

LB - Blood for rabies titer

A: Old scar or previous uveitis
