We are not sure what you are referring to as updates on the status on your drug residue program. We at PDD can comment on your program but the final approval has to be made by the Denver District Office. We commented on 5-18-12 with the following information:

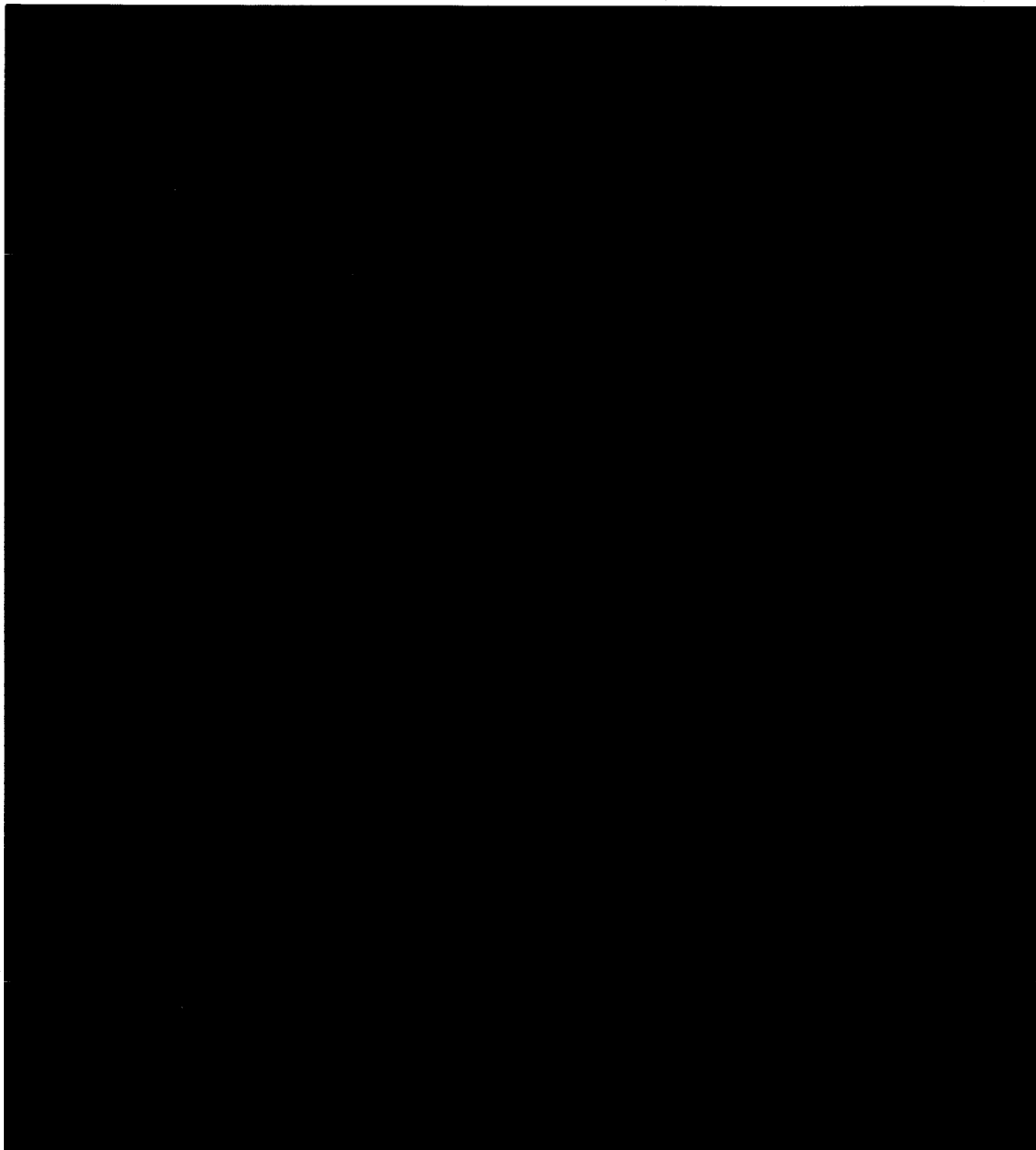
I have reviewed your drug residue program and have the following comments:


This program very closely follows [redacted]. There is one recommendation I will make on the steps you will need to take if FSIS finds a violative residue. Since you have determined that [redacted] a violative residue finding should be followed with all 4 steps of the corrective actions of 9 CFR 417.3 (b). All inspector generated sampled carcasses should be retained by FSIS so 9 CFR 417.3 (b) (1-3) should be done by FSIS in these cases. When there is a scheduled sample FSIS will recommend that the establishment hold the sampled carcass until the results are returned and in this case you will be responsible for 9 CFR 417.3 (b) (1-3). However, in all cases of violative residue findings, the reassessment under 9 CFR 417.3 (b) (4) should be performed.

I have added additional comments/questions to your program below in red that are not necessarily requirements but can add support to your program.
