Dear Congressman Pearce:

Thank you for your letter of March 8, 2012, to the Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Food Safety and Inspection Service (FSIS), on behalf of your constituent, Mr. Ricardo De Los Santos, owner of Valley Meat Company located in Roswell, New Mexico. I appreciate the opportunity to address Mr. De Los Santos' concerns regarding his request to appeal a decision to grant a waiver under FSIS regulations.

Current FSIS regulations require equine slaughter or other preparation of products of equine to be done in establishments separate from any establishment in which cattle, sheep, swine or goats are prepared, in accordance with Title 9 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Section 305.2(b).

The Food Safety and Inspection Service (FSIS) regulations allow waivers, in certain cases, for experimenting with new procedures, equipment, or processing techniques that may be tested to facilitate specific and definite improvements in accordance with 9 CFR 303.1(h). Since the specifics of Mr. De Los Santos' request do not satisfy the conditions for granting a waiver, and would instead simply permit a practice that is prohibited under current regulations, it is not possible to honor Mr. De Los Santos' request for a waiver.

If Mr. De Los Santos wishes to request a federal Grant of Inspection for horse slaughter and processing in a facility separate from other livestock slaughter or processing, consistent with current procedures and regulations, he may request from the FSIS Denver District Office, a Grant of Inspection by filling out FSIS Form 5200-2, Application for Federal Meat and Poultry and Import Inspection.
