**Subject:** Rains Natural Meats Gallatin MO, update.

Good Morning Dr. Gilmore,

We have updated information concerning Rains Natural Meats application.

I spoke with Amanda Sappington today (10:30) and she confirmed that the MO Department of Natural Resources, Water Protection Program did not complete the process and issue a general water permit to Rains. Her office did start the process, but for whatever reason it was not finished, she supposed that Rains did not follow up on his end to move the process to completion.

Additionally, today Friday May 31, 2013 at approximately 8:45 a.m. [REDACTED], HACCP consultant for Rain's Natural horse slaughter program called SEIAO Dr. Trout. Mr. [REDACTED] let Dr. Trout know that he was developing recall procedures which would be in place by the first of next week. He asked if Dr. Trout had any other questions and Dr. Trout asked if Mr. [REDACTED] had taken care of the HACCP issues identified on his previous visit(s). Mr. [REDACTED] assured Dr. Trout that they had been addressed. At that point, no further questions were identified and the conversation ended at approximately 8:47.

The final walk through (Dr. Clarkson, FLS, and Dr. Trout, SEIAO) is still scheduled for next Thursday, 06-06-2013. That is all.
