The MO DNR returned my calls and I asked about the process for obtaining a general water permit from the water protection program. I was told the DNR had 60 days from the time of receipt of the approved application to issue the permit. Ms. Sappington stated she had not received the application yet as they go through Kansas City first and then come to her office. She agreed that she saw no reason for the process to be delayed past the DNR's 60 day limit. That is all the new information I have since Mr. Kiecker's update this morning on the planned residue sampling program. Thank You.
